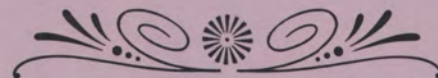

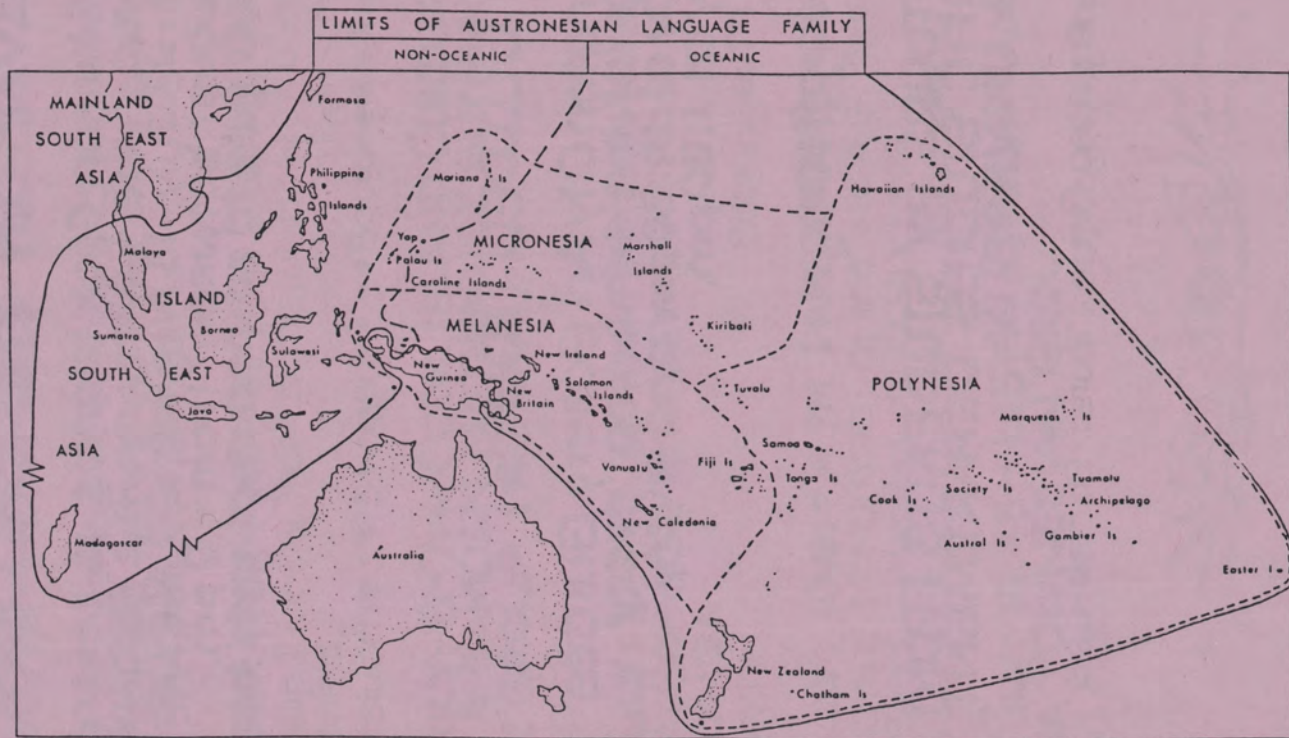
The Wellington City Art Gallery Guides give tours of the exhibition every Thursday at 12.30pm and every Saturday at 1.30pm.
